

THE SAMUEL TROTH & LOUIZA LAMMAS FAMILY HISTORY



1) Samuel Troth

Born ??-??-1844 Died 24-7-1917 age 73

Father, Richard Troth; mother, Elizabeth nee Crawford.

Baptised at St. Johns Church on 20-3-1844, address was Sidemoor and Richard was a Nailer. Baptised again on 25-12-1848 with brothers Albert and Richard.

In 1851 he is living at 85 Sidemoor aged 7.

Married Louisa Lammas on 2-10-1860 at the Independent Chapel Bromsgrove. He was 20 a Nailer from Sidemoor, father Richard Troth a Nailer. She was 19 a Nailer from Sidemoor, father Thomas Lammas a Nailer. Samuel signed, Louisa made her mark. Witnesses were John Deane & Hannah Bourne both by mark.

Circa December 1860 daughter, Elizabeth was born.

In 1861 he is living at 155 Sidemoor Common aged 18 and a Nailer. With him are his wife Louisa, 18, Nailer and daughter, Elizabeth, 4 months.

Circa 1863 son, Samuel Albert was born.

Circa 1865 son, Frederick was born.

Circa 1868 son, John was born.

On 28-12-1869 daughter, Sarah Ann was born at Sidemoor. Louisa registered the birth by mark stating Sam was a Nailer.

In 1871 he is living at 188 Sidemoor aged 28 and a Nailer. With him are his wife, Louisa, 28,

Nailer; children; Samuel, 8, Scholar; Frederick, 6 Scholar; John, 3, Scholar and Sarah Ann, 1.

Circa 1873 daughter, Frances was born.

Circa 1876 daughter, Emily was born.

Circa 1878 daughter, Lucy was born.

In 1881 he is living at Sidemoor Allotments aged 39 and a Nailer. With him are his wife,

Louisa, 39, Nailer; children; Frederick, 16, Nailer; John, 14, Nailer; Sarah Ann, 11, Scholar; Frances, 8; Emily, 5 and Lucy, 3.

Circa 1882 son, Sydney was born.

FROM THE MESSENGER OF 23-9-1882 page 2 col. 5 PETTY SESSIONS

Samuel Troth Sidemoor was fined 6d with 4/- costs for not sending his child to school.

FROM THE MESSENGER OF 12-11-1887 page 6 col. 4 PETTY SESSIONS

Samuel Troth Sidemoor was charged with being drunk at the Wheatsheaf Inn on October 28th Fined 5/- with 8/- costs. (this could be Sam jnr.)

In 1891 he is living at 131 Sidemoor aged 47 and a Nailer. With him are his wife Louisa, 48, Nailer; children; Samuel, 28, Nailer; Frances, 18, Nailer; Emily, 15, Nailer; Lucy, 12, Scholar; and Sydney, 9, Scholar.

In 1901 he is living at 83 [61] Broad Street aged 58 and a Nailer. With him are his wife, Louisa, 59, Nailer; children; John, 36, Nailer and Sydney, 22, Nailer.

FROM THE MESSENGER OF 28-7-1917 page 6 col. 6 DEATH ANNOUNCEMENT On July 24th at 66 Broad Street Samuel Troth aged 73.

Buried in Bromsgrove cemetery, plot # E444, on 28-7-1917, 'a Nailer from Sidemoor aged 73.'

1W) Louiza Lammas

Born ??-12-1843 Died ??-8-1901 Age 58

Father Thomas Lammas, mother Sophia nee Kimberley.

In 1851 she is living at 81 Sidemoor aged 8. (listed as 'Lomas')

Married Samuel Troth on 2-10-1860 at the Independent Chapel Bromsgrove.

In 1861 she is living at 155 Sidemoor Common aged 18 and a Nailer.

In 1871 she is living at 188 Sidemoor aged 28 and a Nailer.

In 1881 she is living at Sidemoor Allotments aged 39 and a Nailer.

In 1891 she is living at 131 Sidemoor aged 48 and a Nailer.

In 1901 she is living at 83 [61] Broad Street aged 59 and a Nailer.

Louisa Troth was buried in Bromsgrove Cemetery, plot #E444, on 2-9-1901, 'the wife of Samuel Troth from Broad Street, aged 58.'

2) Elizabeth Troth

Born ??-12-1860 Died ??-9-1862 age 1

In 1861 she is living at 155 Sidemoor Common aged 4 months.

Baptised at St.Johns Church on 25-12-1861, address was Sidemoor and Samuel was a Nailer. Elizabeth was buried in Bromsgrove cemetery, plot # A108, on 9-9-1862, 'the daughter of Samuel Troth, aged 1 year 8 months from Sidemoor.'

Birth date is from a tree drawn up by a solicitor at the time of George Jones' death (1986) to decide who was to benefit from his estate.

Baptised at St. Johns Church on 25-12-1863, address was Sidemoor and Samuel was a Nailer. In 1871 he is living at 188 Sidemoor aged 8 and a Scholar.

In 1881 Samuel was a Lodger and nailer aged 18 and single, living with Hannah Kinder at Crabtree Lane, Sidemoor.

From the above mentioned solicitor's evidence and from family knowledge, Samuel lived with Eliza Jones and had children prior to their marriage.

Circa 1884 son, George Jones was born.

On 2-1-1886 son, Ernest Jones was born.

On 4-1-1889 sons, Ernest and Arthur were baptised at St. Johns Church, the illegitimate sons of Eliza Jones, nailer of Sidemoor.

NOTE: There is no mention of a Arthur Jones in the solicitor's data

Circa 1890 son, Frank Jones was born.

In 1891 Samuel is living at 131 Sidemoor aged 28 and a Nailer.

In 1891 Eliza was living with her widowed mother, Sarah, at 23 The Pleck. Eliza's siblings, Elizabeth, and James are also there, as is George, 6, Scholar; Ernest, 3; an Arthur, 3; Frank, 1 and a Sarah aged 4 months.

Ernest's aged should I think read '5'. Arthur and Sarah could be the illegitimate children of Eliza's sister, Elizabeth as they don't get mentioned in the solicitor's data.

On 15-5-1892 daughter, Minnie Jones was born.

Samuel Troth married Eliza Jones on 28-12-1897 at All Saints Church. He was 34 a Nailer from Duke of York Lane, father Samuel Troth a Nailer. She was 32 from Duke of York Lane, father George Jones (decd) a Nailer. Sam signed Eliza made her mark. Witnesses were Frederick Troth and Elizabeth Dyers. (Elizabeth Dyers being Eliza's sister)

On 16-4-1899 son, Frederick was born.

Circa February 1901 son, William was born.

In 1901 he is living at 78 [4] Willow Gardens aged 38 and a Nailer. With him are his wife, Eliza, 38, Nailer; children; George Jones, 16, Railway Machinist; Ernest Jones, 13, Nailer; Frank Jones, 11; Minnie Jones, 9; Frederick Troth, 2 and William Troth, 2 months.

Circa 1902 daughter, Lily was born.

Circa 1904 son, Bertie was born.

Circa 1908 son. Albert was born.

Eliza died on 8-2-1922 aged 59 as the result of being severely burnt when she dropped an oil lamp and her clothes caught fire.

FROM THE MESSENGER OF 11-2-1922 page 10 col. 1 LAMP FATALITY AT SIDEMOOR SAD DEATH OF A SIDEMOOR WOMAN - "IN FLAMES FROM HEAD TO TOE"

At Bromsgrove Police Court on Tuesday evening the Coroner held an enquiry respecting the death of Eliza Troth, aged 59, wife of Samuel Troth, nailmaker, of 4 Willow Gardens, Sidemoor. Which occurred in the Cottage Hospital on Monday evening from burns received the previous day.

Samuel Troth stated that he last saw his wife alive previous to the accident on Sunday evening about 7o'clock when she was in her usual health which was good. He had since identified the body at the hospital.

Alice Wheeler, aged 10, granddaughter of deceased, said she was in the house with her grandmother when the accident happened, about 9.15 on Sunday evening. Deceased took a lighted lamp to go into the pantry to fetch some coal. She then heard her cry out and saw her coming out of the pantry with her clothes all on fire. She went to fetch Mrs Tidmarsh who lives next door, and deceased followed her.

Annie Tidmarsh stated she and her husband were seated by their fireside on Sunday evening when Alice Wheeler came running into the kitchen saying her granny was on fire. They both rushed out and met deceased who was in flames from head to toe. She fell on the garden and they got some jackets and put over her, putting the flames out as best they could. They then carried her into her own house, got her clothes off, and wrapped her in a blanket, putting some oil on her hands which were burnt very badly. Witness sent for the doctor and Police Constable Phillips. The motor ambulance arrived, and deceased was taken to hospital.

Dr. Coaker deposed that he first saw deceased in hospital about 10.0 p.m. on Sunday. She was severely burnt on the face, both arms, both legs and the front of stomach and was suffering severely from shock and in great pain. She never rallied and the case was hopeless from the first. She died about 10.0 p.m. on Monday, death being due to shock following severe burns. The Coroner, in returning a verdict of 'Accidental Death' complimented Mrs Tidmarsh and her husband on the prompt way they had acted.

Eliza was buried in Bromsgrove cemetery, plot #F494, on 11-2-1922, 'the wife of Samuel Troth from Willow Gardens aged 59'

Samuel Albert died on 28-1-1947 aged 83.

Samuel was buried in Bromsgrove cemetery, plot #F494, on 1-2-1947, 'an 83 year old Nailer from 6 Perryfields Crescent'

Samuel and Eliza are buried in the next plot to Abel (John) Troth and Eliza.

In 1901 he is living with his parents at 78 [4] Willow Gardens aged 16, and a Railway Machinist

George Jones married Harriet Bradley on ??-??-19?? At ?????/ Church.

Children; Annie and Lil.

Annie married ?????/ Stokes and had a son, Derek.

Lil married but did not have children

Ernest Jones;

In 1901 he is living with his parents at 78 [4] Willow Gardens aged 13 and a Nailer.

Ernest Jones was baptised 4-1-1889 at St. Johns Church, address was Sidemoor.

Married Olive Wilson on 13-4-1913 at St.Johns Church. He was 25 a Boot Operative from Lickey End, no father's details. She was 23 with no occupation from Lickey End, father Henry Wilson a Nailer. Witnesses were George Wilson and Minnie Wheeler.

On 25-9-1913 son, Ernest George was born and baptised at All Saints Church on 15-10-13, address was York Road and Ernest was a Machinist.

On 21-4-1920 son, Clarence Leonard was born and baptised at All Saints Church on 7-5-1920, address was 17 York Road and Ernest was a Carpenter's Labourer.

George married and had sons, Raymond and Gordon.

Clarence married and had children; Call? and May who married ??? Goode.

There is an Ernest Jones headstone in section U of Bromsgrove cemetery 'died 22-11-1943 aged 55'. Could be this Ernest.

An Ernest George Jones was buried in Bromsgrove New Cemetery plot #A225, on 4-11-1954, 'a 41 year old Tyre Fitter from 25 Crabtree Lane.' This could be the son for.....

Olive Jones was buried in Bromsgrove New Cemetery, plot #A225 on 7-4-1966, a 75 year old widow from 57 Spadesbourne Road.'

An Arthur Jones may fit in here [bapt with Ernest above on 4-1-1889]

Frank Jones;

In 1901 he is living with his parents at 78 [4] Willow Gardens aged 11. Frank Jones died without issue.

Minnie Jones;

In 1901 she is living with her parents at 78 [4] Willow Gardens aged 9.

Minnie Jones married Bertie Wheeler at St.Johns on 24-12-1910. He was 20 a Blacksmith from Sidemoor, father John a Wagon lifter. She was 19 with no occupation from Willow Gardens and no father's details. Both sign. Witnesses were George Jones and Elizabeth Dyers by mark.

On 19-2-1911 only child, daughter, Alice was born and baptised at St.Johns on 21-5-1911, address was Church Road and Bert was a Blacksmith.

This must be the Alice Wheeler who gives evidence at the inquest into Eliza Troth's death (listed as granddaughter) in 1922.

Alice married Leslie Luther Ross on 20-5-1933 at ???????/ Church.

On 30-6-1933 daughter, Doreen Audrey was born and baptised at St.Johns Church on 20-7-1933, address was Sidemoor and Leslie was a Labourer.;

On ??-??-19?? Son, John Leslie was born and baptised at St.Johns Church on 20-1-1935, address was 207 Broad Street.

John L. married Pauline Dyer. Children; Charon Lorraine b.26-2-60.

Nigel b.27-12-62 All bapt at Ebenezer Shaun b.27-12-62 Wayne Leslie b.4-6-67

On ??-??-19?? Son, Geoff;

On ??-??-19?? Daughter, Pauline;

On ??-??-19?? Son, Phillip.

Minnie was known as 'Meg' and had a milk business with her husband. They lived at Timberhonger for many years before moving to Churchfields.

Bertie was buried in Bromsgrove New Cemetery, plot #D95, on 12-1-1967, 'a retired 76 year old from 7 Churchfields.'

Nellie [sic] was buried in Bromsgrove New Cemetery, plot #D95, on 2-5-1978, 'the 85 year old widow of Bert from 35 All Saints Road.'

Frederick Troth;

Frederick was baptised at St.Johns Church on 30-4-1899, address was Sidemoor and Samuel was a Nailer.

Frederick was known as 'Ted'.

In 1901 he is living with his parents at 78 [4] Willow Gardens aged 2.

Frederick married Cissie Walters on 1-11-1924 at Catshill Church. He was 25 a Labourer from Willow Gardens, father Samuel Troth a Nailer. She was 26 with no occupation from Barley Mow Catshill, no father's details. Witnesses were Eli Gould and William Troth.

On 8-9-1929 daughter, Pamela Eileen was born and baptised at Catshill Church on 6-10-29, address was 2 Melbourne Road and Frederick was a Labourer.

Pamela never married. Died on 27-1-2001 aged 71 at her home in Melbourne Road.

On 27-1-1932 daughter, Mary Josephine was born and baptised at St.Johns Church on 18-2-1932, address was 2 Melbourne Road and Frederick was a Labourer.

Mary married ????/ Liddell.

On 21-10-1934 son, James Frederick was born.

On 11-4-1937 daughter, Joan Ellen was born.

Joan married Hugh Breen.

On 22-10-1938 son, Cyril Bryan was born.

Frederick Troth died on 1-11-1972.

Frederick was buried in Bromsgrove Cemetery, plot #H12, on 7-11-1972, 'a retired 73 year old Caretaker from 27 Melbourne Road.'

Cissie died in 1979.

Cissie was buried in Bromsgrove Cemetery, plot #H12, on 22-2-1979, 'the 80 year old widow of Frederick from 27 Melbourne Road.'

William Troth:

In 1901 he is living with his parents at 78 [4] Willow Gardens aged 2 months.

William married Winifred Banner on 1-8-1925 at Catshill Church. He was 24 a Wood Worker from Willow Gardens, father Samuel Troth a Nailer. She was 22 a Land Worker from Bournheath, father Jepthan Banner a Market Gardener. Witnesses were Jepthan Banner and Frederick Troth.

On 15-7-1930 son, Gordon William was born and baptised at Catshill on 3-8-30, address was Bournheath and William was a Mechanic.

On 22-3-1937 daughter, Violet Winifred was born and baptised at Catshill Church, address was Bournheath and William was a Wood Worker.

Gordon William Troth married Peggy Chance on 24-5-1958 at Catshill Church. He was 27 a Market Gardener from 54 Doctors Hill, father William Troth a Factory Worker. She was 22 a Factory Worker from Middle Road Dodford, father Samuel Chance (decd). Witnesses were C.L. Billson and P.H. Walton.

Gordon & Peggy have a smallholding at Bournheath.

They have two boys;

Michael Gordon, b.14-12-1959 and baptised a Fairfield on 24-1-60, address was The Caravan, Wood Lane and Gordon was a Market Gardener.

Geoffrey Colin, b.21-12-1963 and baptized at Fairfield on 15-3-1964, address was Wood Lane and Gordon was a Market Gardener.

Michael married Louise Whitcombe and has children; Scott and Tanya.

Geoff married Helena Lowe and has children; Dale and Jessica.

Violet married Peter Harry Walton on 5-7-1958 at Catshill Church. He was 27 a Factory Worker from Worms Ash, father Charles Walton retired. She was 21 a Factory Worker from 54 Doctors Hill, father William Troth a Factory Worker. Witnesses were W. Troth and E.B. Crawford.

no children.

William died on 22-10-1969 aged 68.

Winifred Beatrice died on 20-1-1993 aged 89.

They are both buried in Catshill cemetery.

Lily was baptised at St.Johns on 1-6-1902, address was Willow Gardens and Samuel was a Nailer.

Lily married Frank Clifford Jones on 6-9-1924 at All Saints Church. He was 23 a Carpenter from Bewell Head, father Frank Jones(decd) a Bricklayer. She was 22 with no occupation from Willow Road, father Samuel Troth a Nailer. Witnesses were George Jones and Doris Eva Jones.

Info from Gordon Troth; Daughter, Barbara L. married John Matthews lives 176 Stourbridge Road.

Daughter Betty? married Peter Harper lives 58 Wildmoor Lane. Children; Claire, Jayne, Paul and Mark.

And a son, Raymond.

Info from Sam Troth; a daughter Peggy died aged 11? Of Scarlet fever.

Info from Audrey Wheeler; Ray Jones was born circa 1926-8 and married Jennie Mawhinney – had two children, Derek killed on motor bike accident aged about 17/18. And Lillian who married and had 2 children; her son died in an accident when concrete stairs he was installing at a house in Martley fell on him. Ray lives in Worcester.

Derek Frank Jones was buried in Bromsgrove New Cemetery, plot #D245, on 16-11-1964, 'the 17 year old son of Raymond Frank Jones from 78 Perryfield Crescent.'

Circa 1928 daughter, Norah Elsie (Peggy) was born.

Peggy died on 25-9-1936 aged 8 and was buried in Bromsgrove cemetery, plot #U28, on 29-9-36, 'the 8 year old daughter of Clifford from Bewell Head.' [buried with her Uncle Bert.] Frank Clifford Jones was buried in Bromsgrove New Cemetery, plot #D246, on 20-5-1964, 'a 63 year old Carpenter from 6 Perryfields Crescent'

Lily Jones was buried in Bromsgrove New Cemetery, plot #D246, on 20-10-1992, 'the 90 year old widow of Frank Clifford from 6 Perryfields Crescent'

Bertie was baptised at St.Johns Church on 4-9-1904, address was Willow Gardens and Samuel was a Nailer

It would appear from the evidence of Sam and Gordon Troth that it was Bertie who died of Consumption.

Bert died on 5-7-1936 aged 32.

Bertram Troth was buried in Bromsgrove Cemetery, plot #U28, on 9-7-36, 'a 32 year old Labourer from Willow Gardens'

Albert was baptised at St.Johns Church on 7-6-1908, address was Willow Gardens and Samuel was a Nailer.

Albert was known as 'Dink'

Married Emma Topliss in the 2nd qtr 1929 at Bromsgrove.

On 9-7-1930 daughter, June Doreen was born and baptised at St.Johns Church on 25-7-1930, address was 1 Willow Gardens and Albert was a Trimmer.

June has never married but has a son, David.

On 22-12-1931 son, Samuel Albert was born and baptised at St.Johns Church on 7-1-1932, address was 1 Willow Gardens and Albert was a Stoker.

Samuel Albert married Mary E. ????? and lives in Finstall Rd.

Dink was the Steward of Bromsgrove Labour club in Church Road for many years. He died in 1986.

Albert was buried in Bromsgrove Cemetery, plot #C475, on 31-1-1986, 'a retired 77 year old from 28 Broad Street.'


No mention of Emma in Cemetery records.

Info from Gordon Troth; Samuel and Eliza lived together before getting married and had children by the name of Jones. One of dad's brothers died of consumption in Romsley hospital circa 1938. May have been Bertie or Albert. Another brother nicknamed 'Dink' Troth married Emma? And had children; Sam and Doreen. Sam lives in Finstall Road opposite Ruby club. Doreen lives at bottom of Broad Street where the shops used to be. Dink owned the shops and had the houses built. Another of Dad's brothers lived at Rubery by the Plough and died sometime around the By-pass being put in.

Info from Samuel Troth; Dad was known as 'Dink'. There were Jones siblings. It was 'Peek' Troth who lived at Rubery. It was Bertie who died of consumption.

Info from Pamela Troth and Joan Breen would suggest that 'Peek' Troth's name was Peter. No Peter Troth appears on the tree drawn up by the solicitor – so was Peek Troth really Peter, the son of Frederick and Selina and therefore a cousin and not a brother to Frederick (Ted). Suggested death year for 'Peek' was 1955.

4) Frederick Troth

Baptised at St.Johns Church on 25-12-1865, address was Sidemoor and Samuel was a Nailer. In 1871 he is living at 188 Sidemoor aged 6 and a Scholar.

In 1881 he is living at Sidemoor Allotments aged 16 and a Nailer.

Frederick Troth married Selina Crawford on 7-8-1888 at St.Johns Church. He was 22 a Nailer from Sidemoor, father Samuel Troth a Nailer. She was 28 a widow and Nailer from Hanover Street with no lawful father (but formerly a Stanton). Frederick signed Selina made her mark. Witnesses were Alfred Troth and Sarah Ann Troth by mark.

On 16-6-1889 daughter, Elizabeth was born.

In 1891 they are living at 168 Kidderminster Road, both Nailers aged 26 and 32 respectively. With them are Elizabeth Troth aged 1 and 4 of Selina's children from her 1st marriage to George Crawford.

On 17-4-1892 daughter, Susan was born at Kidderminster Road, Bromsgrove. Selina registered the birth by mark stating she was 'late Stanton formerly Crawford' and that Fred was a Nailer. On 4-5-1895 son, Alexander was born.

On 3-1-1897 daughter, Margaret was born.

In 1901 he is living at 51 [24] St.Johns Street aged 34 and an Iron Worker. With him are his wife, Selina, 41, no occupation; children; Frank Crawford, 19, Wagon Repairer; Florence Crawford, 17, Boot Factory Hand; George Crawford, 14, Wagon Repairer; Lizzie Troth, 11; Susan Troth, 9; Alexander Troth, 5 and Margaret Troth, 3.

On 21-9-1901 son, Frederick was born.

An article in the Messenger dated 21-8-1915 page 8 col. 2 (death of George Crawford) states that Mrs F. Troth is living at Evesham Road Headless Cross.

FROM GILL REYNOLDS (granddaughter of Susan Troth) Fred & Selina had children; Elizabeth, Susan, b.17-4-1892, Margaret, Peter, Bert and Alex. (not in age order)

OF THE CHILDREN:

Elizabeth was admitted to the C. of E. Infants School on 16-4-1894, address was Kidderminster Road. Next of kin was Frederick Troth. Transferred to girls school.

Susan was admitted to the C.of E. Infants School on 17-4-1894, address was Kidderminster Road. Next of kin was Frederick Troth. Transferred to girls school.

Susan Troth married 1^{stly} George Harold Watton on 29-12-1907 at Ebenezer Methodist Chapel, Sidemoor. He was 22 a General Labourer from Broad Street, no father's details (illegit son of Laura Watton). She was 18 (but really only 15.5) a Box maker from Church Road, Sidemoor, father Frederick Troth a Nailer. Both sign. Witnesses were Frank Archibald Crawford and Ellen Wheeler.

On 28-7-1908 daughter Laura Lillian was born at 28 York Road Sidemoor. (d.14-1-92) Laura married Ernest Leslie Mutton. Children; Nigel & Gillian

On 5-3-1910 son, Christopher George was born. (died 31-8-76)

Christopher married Gladys Bott. Children; Maureen & Peter.

On 15-4-1926 daughter, Beryl Margaret was born at 50 Park Road Redditch. Beryl married Kenneth Grubb. Children; Helen & Rodney.

George died on 30-9-1957 at 50 Park Road Redditch aged 72.

Married 2nd Reginald Perry Webber on 26-12-1960 at St.Stephens Church Redditch. He was 56 a widower and Railway Engine Driver from 11 Hazel Road Batchley, father Charles Thomas Webber (decd). She was 68 a widow with no occupation from 9 Oakley Road Redditch, father Frederick Troth (decd). Witnesses were Christopher George Watton and Dennis Albert Powell. Susan walked from Bromsgrove to Redditch to work at Abel Morrels – Then bought a shop
